Dating back to the 19th century, the old city of Hebron became a main destination for Glass production in Palestine. The flourishing glass industry is attributed to the traditional Phoenician glass blowing technique that Palestinians adopted and improved. Artisans in Hebron also use recycled bottles and other environmentally friendly practices that stems from the sustainable approaches Palestinians practice in daily life with a culture that focuses

on reusing products in various ways to minimize waste created around the house and on the community level. Today, the “Glass-Blower Quarter” still exists in the old city, where glass blowing is a family trade in Hebron. With more modern techniques on the rise, the art of traditional glass blowing is being preserved and practiced by a few families that own glass factories in the city.

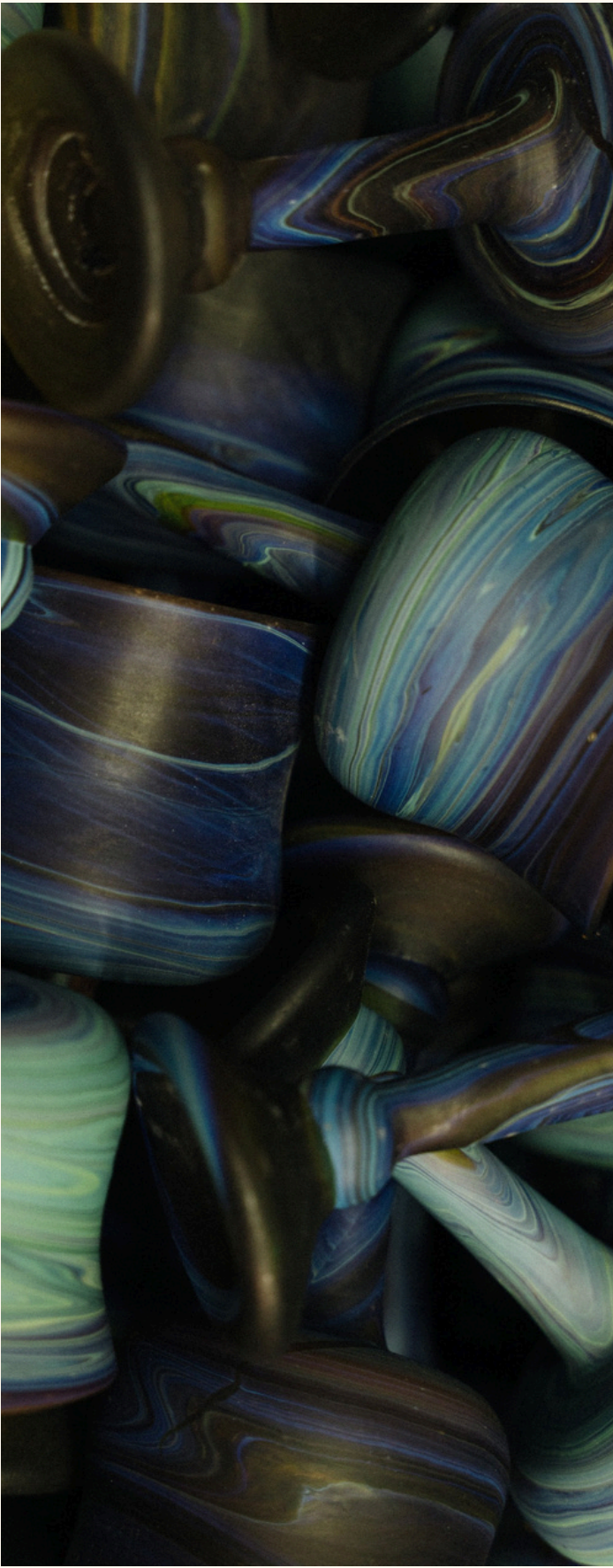

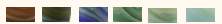
The Phoenician Style Glass collection

THE HEBRON STYLE GLASS COLLECTION

This Hebron Style Glass collection. The factory cycles through six colors—cobalt, blue, green, purple, brown, and clear—year-round. Each hue undergoes a two to three-month oven process. A multicolored order will require additional time due to the oven color changes.

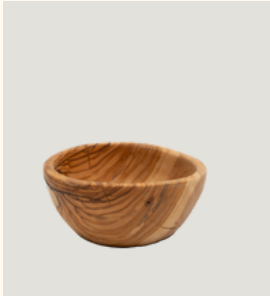


Olive Wood

Palestine boasts ancient olive trees dating back 4,000 years, symbolizing peace and resilience. The olive tree, central to Palestinian culture, is intricately carved by skilled artisans, a tradition dating to the 4th century. The Palestinians were creative by collecting olive branches from olive groves all over the Westbank like Tulkarm and Nablus regions, and avoiding cutting down any olive tree in spite of the expansion of the olive wood industry in order to sustain an ethical handcraft approach. The process requires an intense

labor and a number of artisans that work through several stages, starting from using drilling machines saves time and effort in carving, and also facilitates the skilled artisan job that requires a lot of focus into details, before the piece is coated with olive wax to ensure longevity.

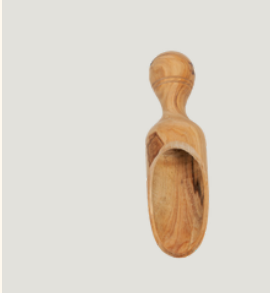

Ceramics

The Armenian ceramic legacy in Jerusalem sparked a transformation in the local pottery scene, later embraced by Palestinian artisans who infused their unique colors, styles, and motifs reflecting local culture. Hebron emerged as a hub for authentic ceramic production, where family-owned workshops innovated to create pieces blending tradition with international appeal. Employing electric molding wheels, the ceramic-making process involves baking, painting, glazing, and a final bake.

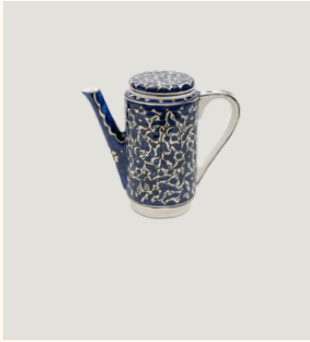

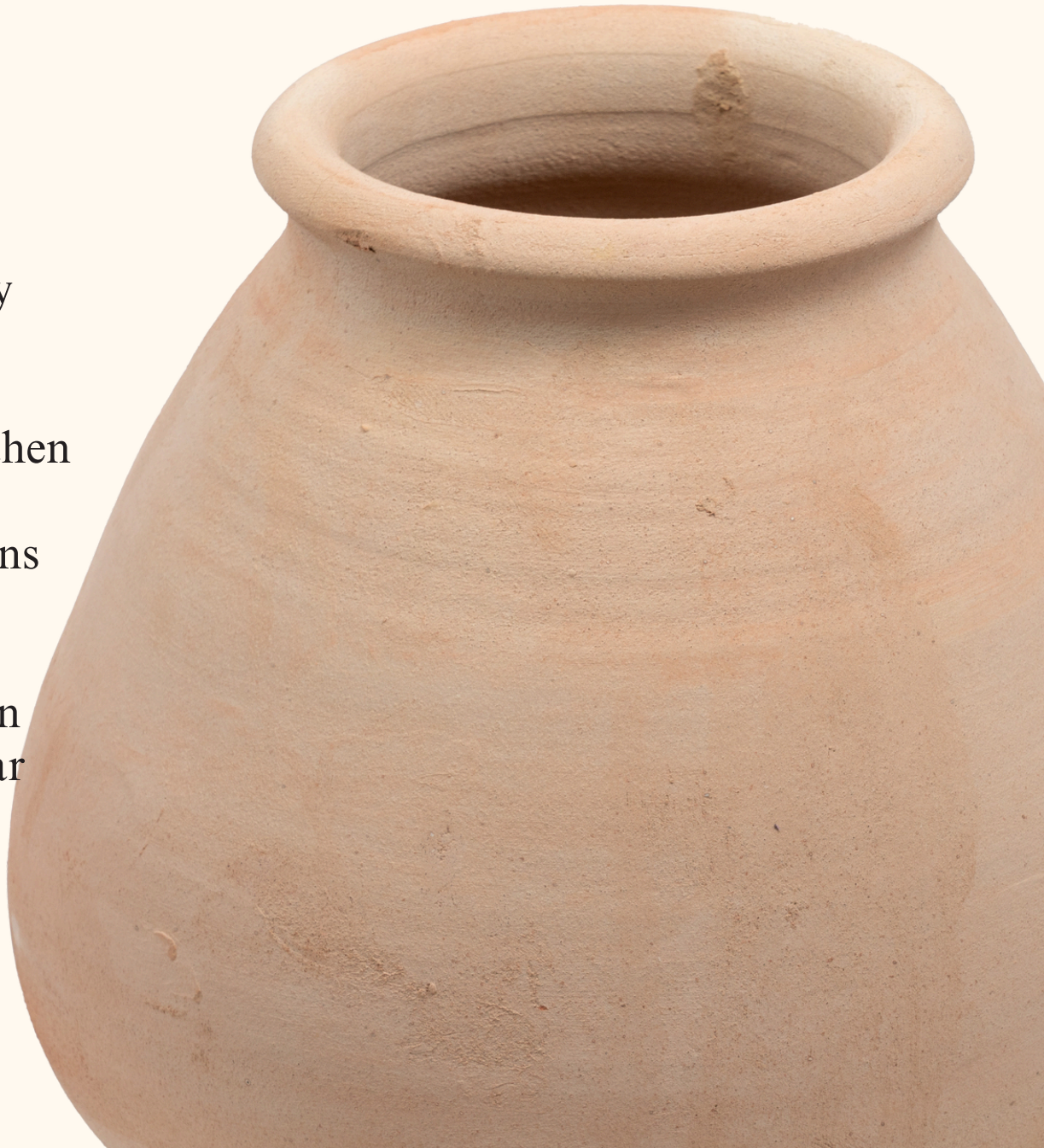

Pottery²⁵

Pottery is considered one of Palestine's oldest crafts. Modern Palestinian pottery dates back to ancient times, handmade using clay where artisans smooth, shape, and then bake pottery pieces into moldable home decor pieces and kitchenware. Palestinians used clay to store food like olive oil and jam. Today, Hebron is also a main destination for pottery where the city has a 300+ year old family-run pottery workshop.

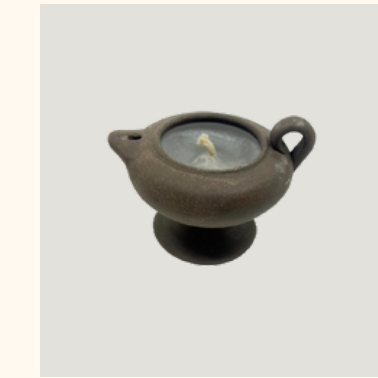

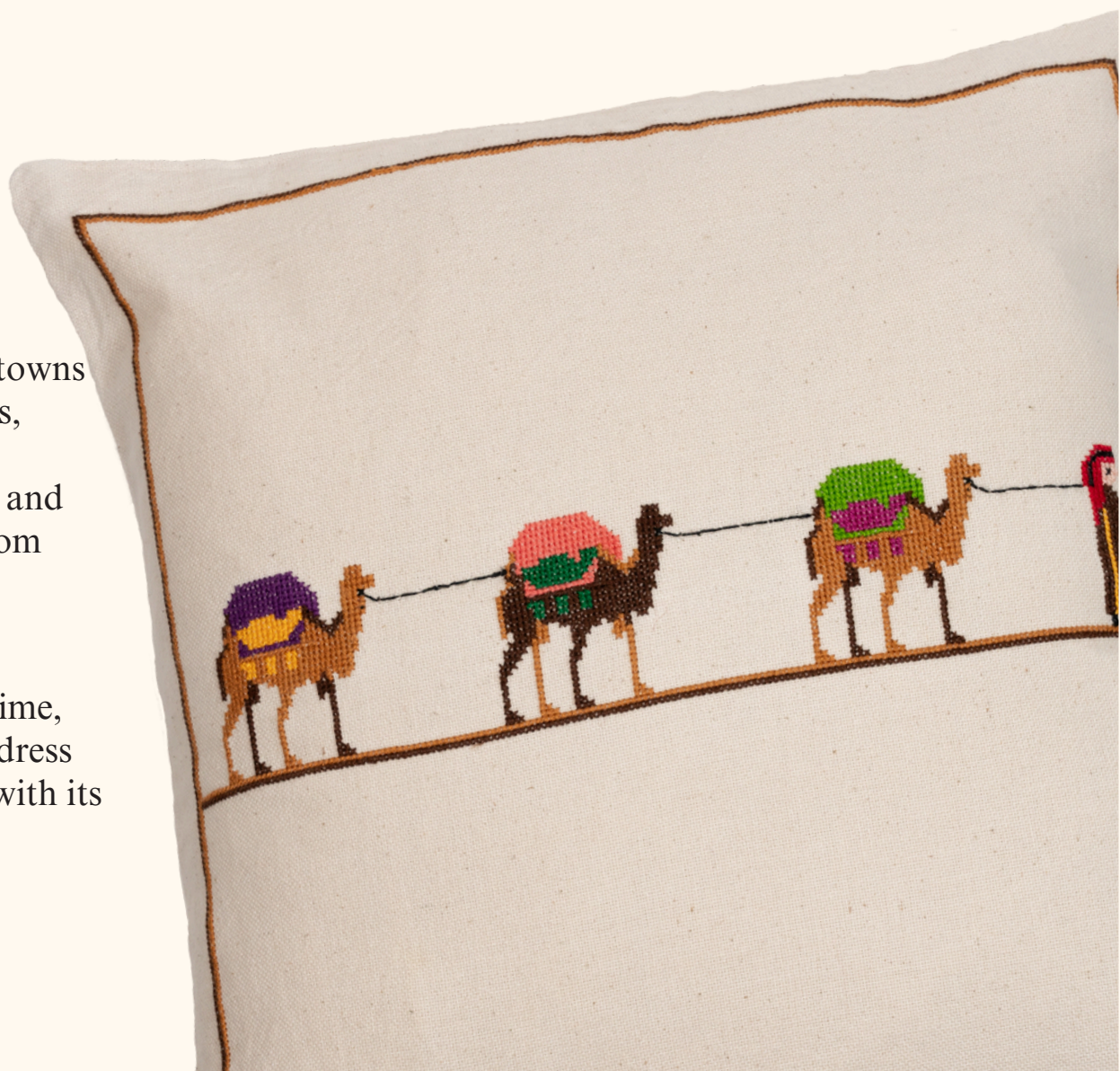

Embroidery

The art of traditional embroidery is widespread around Palestine. Due to Palestine's unique geographical locations, different cities and towns in Palestine added their own cultural characteristics, techniques, and materials to each of their custom dresses. The women developed various cross-stitch and couching hand-embroidery techniques that vary from one town to another with symbols, patterns, and colours

inspired by Palestine's culture and landscape. Overtime, each city/town became known for a certain custom dress that reflects the story of how this art came into life with its unique textures and motifs.

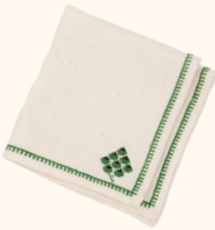

Leather

Palestine has a rich history in the leather industry, dating back thousands of years when humans recognized the multifaceted utility of animals beyond sustenance. The craft flourished in Palestine during the Islamic rule, reaching its zenith in the mid20-th century. At the epicenter of this tradition is Hebron City, a thriving hub for leather production. Artisans in Hebron skillfully work with high-quality cow, goat, and calf leather to craft an array of products,

primarily shoes, but also extending to contemporary items such as bags, wallets, and laptop cases. This industry's longevity and adaptability showcase the enduring legacy of leather crafting in Palestine, where traditional techniques meld seamlessly with modern demands, reflecting a heritage deeply embedded in the artistry of leather.

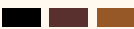

Sheep Wool

The art of woven wool and working with sheep skin and hides requires multiple steps starting from shearing and washing the animal hair, then spinning the wool using a wooden spindle before it is rolled into a ball and soaked in a natural dye for colouring. After that, a group of women use a ground loom ‘noul’ and weave the wool into a fabric that can be used for rugs, pillows, and wall hangings. The women also use the woven wool to create their home tents, saddle bags for their animals, and small ornaments.
