




THE CREATIVE PROCESS







MIA COLLECTION An explorative journey with Mia Benita








FOZ COLLECTION Foz do Douro - Where the river meets the sea

The Douro river finally meets the sea at Foz do Douro. At the Maregrafo in Foz, stone steps lead down to the water on the western side of the jetty. From here, close to the water's edge, we can see and hear the very particular events of this place. As the waters from ocean and land meet, the line between the two is visible as turbulent bodies of waters from distant places finally merge.

Beyond the sounds of this interaction, we also hear sounds of city and ocean serving as a back⊠drop. Small boats, distant traffic, ocean waves breaking on the sea wall further out. It is a highly textured soundscape full of detail.
