Working alongside her husband, Victor-Amédée, she forged nails in the Savoy region, in the heart of the French Alps.

The collection consists of knives with comfortable, rounded handles and micro-serrated blades, as well as sleekly designed forks and spoons, suitable for use with any Opinel table knives.

The Perpétue utensils are made from dishwasher-safe monobloc stainless steel. The knife is made from X20Cr13 steel, while the fork and spoons are made from X5CrNi18-10 steel.
